## Pivoting & Employee Impact During COVID-19 – v. 3/29/20

One of the challenges for small businesses that are needing to change their business model is thinking through what that change means for them as employers and for their employees.

- o How does the pivot affect what jobs you need done within your company?
  - Consider employee input.
  - Identify what functions remain as is.
  - Identify what functions go away.
  - Identify what new functions you incur.
  - Identify employees that are capable of pivoting to perform new functions.
  - Do what you can to help them understand the changes:
    - their new roles and responsibilities
    - challenges that they might encounter
    - training they might need
    - benchmarks against which they will be evaluated
    - timeframe for adjustment
    - resources available to assist them
- o Do you need to make staff reductions: workweek reductions, furloughs, layoffs?
  - If so, and you have a Payroll Protection Program loan, this may affect the amount of forgiveness for which you qualify
  - > Comply with labor laws for non-discrimination. This applies in rehiring as well.
  - Comply with federal and state WARN Acts and OWBPA
  - Use your employee handbook and follow your policies and procedures
  - Confer with a contract HR firm if needed
  - Notify laid off employees of resources for assistance, e.g., unemployment insurance, special enrollment window for health insurance, etc.
- o Do you need to make changes to your compensation structure?
  - If so, and you have a Payroll Protection Program loan, this may affect the amount of forgiveness for which you qualify
- What types of communication do you need to have with your employees and what do they need to have with each other? This is especially important to understand if you are used to working together at a physical location and are now working remotely, if employees 'roles have changed, or if you have new team members.
- O What are your best tools for communication?
- What can you do to keep up company culture and employee engagement when physically distanced and working remotely?
- o Review and update or develop employee handbook and policies and procedures.
